

ОБЩАЯ ИСТОРИЯ РОЗДРОБЛЕННЫХ ПРОСТРАНСТВ: МЕДИАТИЗАЦИЯ ИСТОРИЧЕСКОЙ НАУКИ В УКРАИНЕ И ВОСТОЧНОЙ ЕВРОПЕ

Аннотация. В статье рассматривается нарастающее заимствование медиа-логики и соответствующие изменения габитуса в поле академической истории в Восточной Европе, особенно в Украине. Исходя из теории медиатизации и исследований памяти, авторы рассматривают ряд соответствующих явлений в регионе, перед тем как сосредоточиться на случае Ликбеза, низовой инициативы украинских историков, направленной на разоблачение исторических мифов как в Украине, так и вне страны. Делается вывод, что сочетание исторического знания и многочисленных медиа-платформ для его распространения открывает эру медиатизации истории.
